"We need to honor the past and the accomplishments of so many, while ensuring that independent distribution always focuses on how we deliver checks to orphans, widows, and business owner in their greatest time of need. That is what NAILBA is working on and what we will spend our energy trying to deliver for our membership."

In addition to his leadership in NAILBA, Gilbert has also been active in the local NAIFA chapter and was the 2016 President of The TYGERS, a study group of second and third generation insurance professionals.
